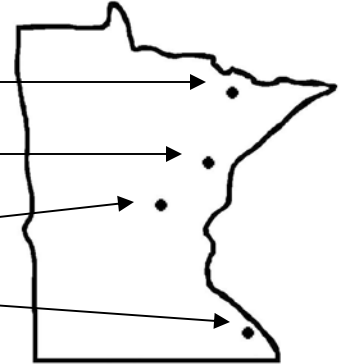

Cloquet Forestry Center: Take the Hwy 210 exit off of I-35. Head west on 210 for 2.7 miles to County Hwy 5. Take a right on County Hwy 5/University Road for approximately 2.5 miles. The Cloquet Forestry Center is off to the left. Contact Mike Reichenbach at (218) 726-6470 for more information.

Crow Wing County: From Deerwood, take MN-6 south off of MN-210. Go approximately 4 miles, then turn left (East) onto Black Bear Drive. Contact Dennis Thompson at (218) 927-6565 for more information.
